

INSTALLATION

NOTE: The FCAC is intended to assist with alignment of LCM menu boards and ceiling mounted video walls.

WARNING: Displays may NOT be attached to the FCAC OR mounted across the FCAC. The FCAC is NOT intended to be a load-bearing accessory.

- Assemble LCM Ceiling Mounted Menu Boards Series or LCM Ceiling Mounted Video Walls Series, according to included installation instructions.
- Rotate end cap on one end of rail by loosening one screw and removing one screw holding end cap to rail. (See Figure 1)
- 3. Repeat Step 2 for end of adjacent rail. (See Figure 1)



- 4. Insert two T-slot nuts (B) into rail. (See Figure 2)
- 5. Rotate end cap back into position and fasten with screws loosened or removed in Steps 2 and 3. (See Figure 2)
- 6. Repeat Steps 4 and 5 for end of adjacent rail. (See Figure 2)



 Attach FCAC (A) to T-slot nuts (B) using eight 1/4-20 hex nuts (C). (See Figure 3)

NOTE: See the maximum spacing and minimum spacing examples of the FCAC. (See Figure 3)


